

MEMBERSHIP TYPES - WHAT YOU SHOULD KNOW:

Currently, the ADA has several membership categories. While a new membership model is being piloted in several states, Nebraska is operating under the long-standing model. The majority of our members fall under 3 membership categories, which are defined below.


- Active Member: A member who is licensed to practice in the state of Nebraska. Active members pay full dues to the ADA, NDA and the ODDS.
- Active Life Member: A member in good standing who has completed 30 consecutive years or 40 total years of active membership and attained the age of sixty. Members that achieve these qualifications may be classified as Active Life members upon nomination by the NDA Board of Trustees and election by the House of Delegates. Active Life members pay full dues to the ADA, receive a 25% dues reduction to the NDA, and receive a 100% dues reduction to the ODDS.
- Retired Life Member: A member in good standing who has met the requirements of active life membership and who has retired from the practice of dentistry. Retired life members receive a 100% dues reduction to the ADA, NDA, and ODDS.

Members achieving Active Life membership are recognized during the awards program at the NDA Annual Session.
This year the Omaha District is proud to recognize Dr.
Jerome Wees and Dr. Paul Krause as Active Life Members.
We thank you for your years of membership and for your years of service to the profession.

Throughout the past year, the Board of Directors received several inquiries about event fees. Previously, the ODDS held six dinner meetings each year. At each of those meetings, non-dues paying members were asked to pay a registration fee *or* were given the option to pay annual dues to the ODDS.

The ODDS now offers 2-3 larger events each year. There are significant costs associated with these events. Active Members of the ODDS *typically* do not pay fees to attend CE or social events as they pay full Omaha District dues, which contribute to ODDS programming costs.

Member categories that do NOT pay Omaha District dues may be required to pay an event registration fee, as voted on by the Board of Directors, to help offset event related expenses.
