

#### DENTAL HYGIENE & DENTAL ASSISTING SCHOLARSHIP

#### THE FUTURE OF THIS SCHOLARSHIP IS IN YOUR HANDS

For many years the Omaha District Dental Society has provided scholarship funds to support students in the Dental Hygiene and Dental Assisting programs at Iowa Western Community College. Current staff shortages in both areas highlight the need for the continuation of this fund. It is imperative that the Omaha Metro continues to have well-trained staff members entering the workforce upon program completion.

In recent years, this scholarship has been singlehandedly funded by one office. We would like to thank Midwest Oral Surgery & Dental Implants for their many years of supporting this scholarship. We are now calling upon our membership at large to preserve the future of this scholarship.

In the annual budget, which was approved during the August 22, 2024 Membership Meeting, it was decided that the ODDS would maintain a \$2,500 scholarship to be sent to IWCC prior to their established awarding deadlines. This will provide a \$1,000 Dental Assisting and a \$1,500 Dental Hygiene Scholarship, to benefit students during the 2025-2026 Academic Year.

ODDS Members, we are asking for your support in continuing this scholarship. Please consider making a monetary contribution to the ODDS, to be used in funding this scholarship. If 25 offices make a \$100 contribution, the scholarship will be fully funded. In turn, your office will be recognized on a flyer distributed to students in each program with hopes that they will seek out these practices when considering their employment options.
